COVID Safe Plan

If you are feeling unwell or have any symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough or sore throat) please do not attend Mass.

Please register with the Parish Office during office hours on 53 312 933 or ballarat@ballarat.catholic.org.au to attend all Masses
(Office Hours: Tuesday – Friday 10.00am to 5.00pm)

Please ensure you arrive 10 minutes before Mass; doors of the Cathedral will be locked prior to commencement.

- Registration is required to attend all Masses.
Action: A 'Contact Tracing' register with name and contact number for all attendees will be held by the Parish Office.
- Ensure that you maintain appropriate physical distancing at all times (1.5 metres).
Action: Positioning of seating will address social distancing requirements.
- A face mask must be worn at all times whilst visiting the Cathedral (your face mask may be removed when consuming Communion or reading, but must be worn again immediately afterwards).
Action: You will be unable to attend Mass if you fail to wear a face mask.
- Please use the hand sanitiser available upon entering the Cathedral.
Action: Hand sanitiser will be made available inside the Cathedral.
- Please do not touch any surfaces unnecessarily.
Action: Cleaning supplies will be available.
- Please remain in the designated area of the Cathedral (in or near your seat at all times).
Action: Signage to indicate designated areas will be displayed.
- Once Mass has concluded, please leave the Cathedral immediately afterwards to allow for cleaning of all surfaces.
Action: Parish Office staff will ensure the venue is locked in a timely manner.

The fines for non-compliance with Government Regulations which may be imposed on the Cathedral are up to \$100,000.
